

Advertisement for the post of Research Assistant and Field Investigator

Applications are invited for the post of Research Assistant (01) for one year and Field Investigator (02) for six months. The Research Assistant and Field Investigator will work on an ICSSR-sponsored project entitled 'भारिया जनजाति का सामाजिक- सांस्कृतिक अध्ययन: पातालकोट छिंदवाड़ा जनपद, मध्य प्रदेश के विशेष संदर्भ में'. The post is purely temporary. The tenure of the Research Assistant appointment will be one year and it can be extended only for six months based on the project requirement and performance of the candidate. The Research Assistant will be paid Rs.16,000=00 (Sixteen thousand) and the Field Investigator will be paid Rs. 15,000=00 (Fifteen thousand) per month as per the ICSSR Rules.
