INTRODUCTION

The skill development programs are highly significant in the Government of India policy, especially in the New Education Policy 2020. The Shortage of skilled workforce in every sector of the economy is quite apparent. Skills are directly related to the labour's marginal productivity and income level. The tribal area people lack opportunities to learn skills which forced them to come under the undeveloped region. To bring the tribes into the mainstream of development, they must be educated, trained, and converted into skilled workers.

The tribal people have some inherent skills and indigenous knowledge like how to hunt, gather roots and berries, understand climate changes, predict the movement of stones, and tradition to save fruit trees for germination. Inherent skills of tribal people will provide new insights for development. Madhya Pradesh, one of the most populated states in India, has the highest tribal population, covering 21.1 percent of the state's population. Basic human needs, i.e., education, employment, health, sanitation, housing, drinking water, road, and social security, are unavailable in tribal areas. They have not been able to reach the envisaged level of development despite different opportunities offered for their economic development.

Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav is an initiative of the Government of India to celebrate and commemorate 75 years of independence and the glorious history of its people, culture, and achievements. This Mahotsav dedicates to the people of India who had been instrumental in bringing India so far in its evolutionary journey and hold within them the power and potential. The spirit of Aatmanirbhar Bharat fuels our honorable Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision of activating India 2.0. Today is the time to introspect the skill development programme and its performance in the tribal area.
